Lyme disease is often called the "Great Masquerader" because it can mask itself as many other diseases.

This program was produced to help remind the viewer that it is people who suffer from Lyme and other tick-borne disease, unmasking the numbers that are often used to describe the extent of Lyme disease's impact on our society.

Lyme Disease Video Quilt unmaskes Lyme disease as people talk about their experiences and feelings. At the end of the 8 minute program, the audience will understand the plight of both younger and older patients. In addition, patients will learn that there is the realistic hope of recovery.
